Artist Statement

We all wear masks for a variety of reasons, to reveal and to conceal, so what is presented on the

outside may not be a reflection of what is truly on the inside.

This series explores the contrasts that exist between perception and reality. The bowl form was

chosen as a metaphor for the container of the soul, our deepest self, and each bowl represents a

different aspect of our relationship with ourselves and with each other – **Bowl #2** - Hard and

stony on the outside (wood fired raku clay), beautiful and delicate on the inside (peacock

feathers, pearls, gold leaf); **Bowl #3** – Velvety, caressable soft on the outside (tufted velvet with

glass beads), thorny and impenetrable on the inside (thorns with paint). It begs the question,

"Who am I being? Who are you seeing?"
