At the Manitoba Libraries Conference in May 2012, the Working Group presented the results of a provincial library association survey, with the results available at http://mblibraries.blogspot.ca.

Each Manitoban association has been asked to discuss these results with their members to seek direction on how to proceed, and MAHIP held a members meeting on 19 September 2012 to have this conversation. A meeting of Manitoba's library association presidents will be held in the near future to share the consensus of the various members and to determine the next steps.
